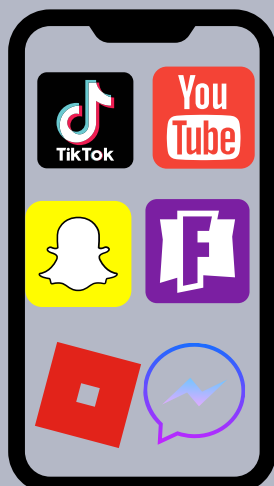

A **DIGITAL FOOTPRINT** is a trail of data you create while using the Internet. It includes the websites you visit, emails you send and information you submit to online services.

Did you know.....

- 70% of employers use social media to screen candidates during their hiring process.
- 51% of employers found information on social media that caused them to turn down the candidate.
- 40% of college admissions reviewed applicants' digital footprints when deciding acceptance.

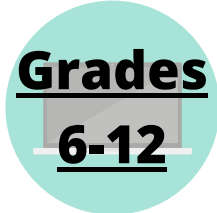
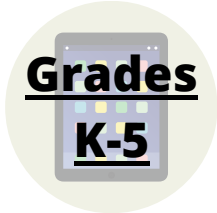

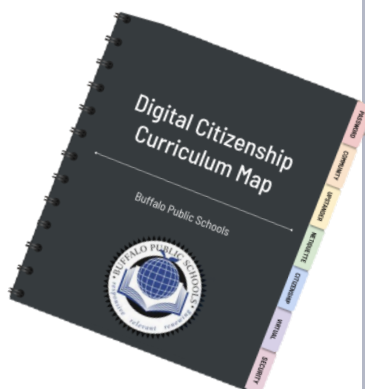
10 Tips for Managing Your Digital Footprint

BY YOR I. DENTITY

1. Limit the data you share.
2. Don't enter personal data on public Wi-Fi.
3. Think before you post. Once it's posted, its permanent even if you delete it.
4. Delete old accounts.
5. Create strong memorable passwords.
6. Frequently search yourself to monitor your footprint.
7. Familiarize yourself with and use privacy settings.
8. Read all terms & conditions for programs and apps.
9. Be an upstander or someone who stands up to cyberbullying and reports inappropriate online behavior.
10. Build your reputation through your words and behavior.
