**COVID – DIAGNOSTIC TESTING**

The consent form below will be utilized by the school nurse for individuals that present symptoms during the day and receive a diagnostic test. **THIS IS DIFFERENT FROM THE “RANDOM” TESTING PROCESS WE CURRENTLY HAVE IN PLACE.** Submitting the permission slip will enable a symptomatic student to be tested at school. **Whether the results are negative or positive, a child will be sent home from school and required to follow protocols because diagnostic testing involves a rapid test. This is NOT test-to-stay.**

**COVID - AT-HOME TEST – POSITIVE RESULT**

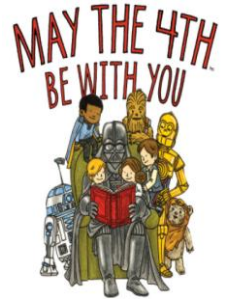

<b>When Your Child is Ill</b>	When your child is ill before the start of the school day, it is required that you keep your child home. If your child becomes ill during the school day, the student will report to the school's CARES Room and you will be contacted to pick the child up, as quickly as possible.
