### Reading

During the month of October, students will learn letter names and sounds. They will begin to work on their handwriting skills and connecting spoken sounds to written letters. They will listen to stories to draw and write a response to text as well as answer questions about a given topic. In grammar, they will learn that nouns can be people, places, animals and things. They will also learn that a verb is an action word.

### Math

In Math we have practiced sorting by size, color and category. Now, we are working on counting, writing, and adding numbers 1 through 10. We will work on figuring out missing numbers when counting both up and down. We are learning that the number zero is used when there are no objects to count.

### Social Studies & Science

In Science we are learning about our senses. We will explore with each of our senses and develop new language to describe the world around us. At home, sort objects by sight, taste, sound, touch and smell. Use all your senses in the season of Fall. In Social Studies the topics include "Myself", "Being Special", and "Family & Friends". We are listening to stories, singing songs, and drawing pictures to share.
