These current BPS students are entered first into a lottery for those seats. This policy is subject to change by the Buffalo Board of Education.

Information for Current BPS Students

No further application documents are needed for **current** BPS students. Other entrance criteria, including prior year Report Card and Attendance Record, are already on file.

Students interested in **5th, 7th, or 9th grade for 2020-2021** may test at their home school. Please contact your child's Principal.

Students applying for **6th, 8th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grades for 2020-2021** cannot test at their home school. See above for test dates and times. Please bring IEP, 504, or ELL documents if applicable.

REQUIREMENTS for Non-BPS Students

Non-BPS students **MUST** present documents below on testing day. Without **ALL** required documents, your child **WILL NOT TEST**:

- Two (2) distinct proofs of City of Buffalo residency (Choose 2 different proofs from the list of 4 below showing your Buffalo address):
 1. Parent's New York State Driver's license or non-driver's license
 2. Gas, cable, or electric bill from within last 30 days (only 1 may be used; no other utility bills acceptable)
 3. Parent's pay stub from within last 30 days
 4. Notice of Decision from the Erie County Department of Social Services from 2019
- Applicant's Final CUMULATIVE 2018-19 Report Card
- Applicant's Final CUMULATIVE 2018-19 school attendance record (may appear on the report card)
- Completed 2020-21 Elementary or High School Application (available at www.buffaloschools.org)
- Current IEP, 504, or ELL documents (if applicable)
