Administration will host virtual office hours to meet with parents.
4. (when in person school resumes) allow parents to volunteer at any school function, during any lunch period, or during other times specified by the Principal. South Park High School will also allow parents to participate and/or observe any classroom activities, provided prior notice is given. While instruction is virtual, parent participation will be encouraged for SBMT, PTO and virtual events including fundraisers.

Parent Responsibilities

We, as parents, will support our children's learning by:

1. monitoring their attendance, and supporting their attendance in school daily.
2. making sure their homework is done to satisfaction of the teacher.
3. monitoring screen time and use and promoting positive use of extracurricular time.
4. staying informed about their education and communicating with the school by reading all notices brought or mailed home, e-mailed, or relayed via the telephone messaging system. We will also respond to such communication in a timely manner as appropriate.

Student Responsibilities

We, as students, will share the responsibility to improve our academic achievement and achieve the State’s highest standards. Specifically, we will:

1. attend school; including being on time every day to every class. This includes logging into Schoology and Teams Meetings for synchronous and asynchronous instruction.
2. do the school/homework which is required of us by our teachers, and ask for clarification and guidance when needed.
3. give to my parents and guardians all notices and information received from my school.
