Final Weeks of 2020-21 School Year

The final day of school for our students is Thursday, June 24th. We remain focused on fitting every bit of learning we can into these final 18 days. We ask that parents continue to partner with us and be mindful of the following rules which have served us well in making the very best of the situation this year:

- ☑ If a student is not feeling well or has a fever, please remain home and log onto your classes via Schoology/Teams.
- ☑ All students and adults entering the school building must wear masks.
- ☑ Students who are not taking the bus must be dropped off at the Pawnee entrance.
Doors open at 9:00am and close at 9:25am
- ☑ Please do your very best to have students to school on time. Students arriving later than 9:25 must be brought to the main office and signed into school by an adult.
- ☑ Students in Grades PK-4 who are not taking the bus, must be picked up by a parent, guardian or older sibling and signed out at the Pawnee entrance.
- ☑ No child will be released from the Main office after 3pm. Buses are arriving and the parking lot is too dangerous for parents and students to be using this entrance.

Summer School for Students in Grade PK-6

- Students in PK-6 who have been recommended for Summer School should have received letter by this point.
- Parents are responsible for registering students for summer programming.
- Summer program for students in PK-6 runs from July 12-August 6th
- This is a full day program and students can attend in person or virtual.
- In-person students will receive transportation along with breakfast, lunch and snack.
- Our students will be attending Southside School #93 for Summer School.

Summer School for Students in Grade 7 and 8.

- Students in grades 7 and 8 who have been recommended for Summer School will receive letters this week.
- Parents are responsible for registering students for summer programming. Summer program for students in grades 7 and 8 runs from July 12-August 6th
- Courses offered for students who need to recover classes:
 - ENGLISH 7/8
 - SCIENCE 7/8
 - SOCIALSTUDIES 7/8
 - MATH 7/8
- Transportation will be provided by the NFTA.
- Breakfast and Lunch will be served depending on courses assigned.
