			1 Write A,B,C,__ on paper. Ask, "What comes next? Repeat with new letters.	2 Take a rainy day walk and splash in puddles or do shadow shimmies on a sunny day. (make your shadow dance)	3 Use items around the house. Straws, rubber bands, noodles etc. Form the letters in your name using these objects.	4
5	6 Encourage your child to use words like taller, longer and shorter to describe items in the house.	7 Help your child think of words that rhyme with <i>spring</i> . ( <i>ring, sing, king</i> ).	8 Pattern count to 20 with your child. (clap, stomp, clap, stomp).	9 Draw a  on paper. Let your child color and cut it out. Make it into a kite by adding a tail.	10 Go on a nature walk with your child, look for signs of Spring and make a collage.	11
12	13 Using 10 toys have your child line them up smallest to largest.	14 Count out 6 jelly beans. Add 2 more. Ask, "How many do you have now?" Repeat.	15 Help your child measure the length of a shoe using pennies. What other things can they find to measure?	16 Help your child think of words that rhyme with <i>plant</i> . ( <i>ant, can't, rant</i> )	17 Using plastic cups, build a tower with your child. How many cups did you use? How high can you build the tower before it falls?	18
19	20 Clap the syllables you hear in grow (1) water (2) and sunshine (2).	21 Have your child count to 20. Help them count backwards too!	22 Have your child think of words that start the same as <i>tap</i> . ( <i>tip, top, tug</i> )	23 Ask, "What numbers come between 2 and 7?" Can your child explain their thinking?	24 Have your child build a tower by stacking coins. How many coins were used? Can they find a way to use the coins to make a bridge?	25
26	27 Have your child observe the weather outside. Invite your child to draw/write what they see.	28 Have your child think of words that start the same as <i>up</i> . ( <i>umbrella, ugly, under</i> )	29 Join your child in skipping, hopping bending and jumping to upbeat music.	30 Have your child give you a thumbs up if they hear you say words that rhyme.
