| 3 | 4 Ask, "What number comes between 4 and 6?" Repeat with new numbers. | 5 Have your child think of words that start the same as van. (vet, vote, view) | 6 Have your child list 5 things they know about the four seasons. | 7 Ask your child to draw his/her favorite thing to do with Mom, Grandma or an Aunt. Have them draw and write about that person. | 8 Use recyclables or household objects to see who can build the strongest bridge. | 9 |
| 10 Mother's Day  | 11 Have your child think of words that start the same as wig. (wag, wipe, wet) | 12 Go for a walk with your child. How many shapes can you find in your neighborhood? | 13 Invite your child to write the letters as you name them. Start with the letters in their name. | 14 Give your child 10 items. Take away two. Ask, "How many are left?" Repeat. | 15 Fill a bowl with ice. Shake salt over the cubes and watch what happens. Talk about the change that occurred. | 16 |
| 17 | 18 Have your child think of words that have the sound of Xx . (taxi, exit, fox) | 19 Ask your child to place 5 toys in a row. Can he/she identify their order? (first, second etc.) | 20 Clap the syllables you hear in baby (2) seed (1) and butterfly (3). | 21 Have your child hop on their left foot 6 times, then on their right foot 8 times. Repeat with different actions. | 22 Line a bowl or tray with baking powder. Use a dropper to add vinegar. Watch the fizz happen! (Add food coloring to the vinegar for more fun). | 23 |
