7	8 Help your child learn their birthdate. Have him/her draw a cake with the correct number of candles.	9 Go on a color walk. What colors do you see? Do you have a favorite?	10 Help your child learn their address. Draw a house and label it with the street name and house number.	11 Practice number recognition by playing hopscotch with your child.	12 Change how an egg floats or sinks in a glass by adding salt to the water.	13
14	15 Have your child write and count the letters in their name.	16 Read a story to your child. Can they retell it? Who is their favorite character?	17 Play shadow tag with your child.	18 Make rhyming sentences with your child. "The fat cat sat on a mat".	19 Grow mold on bread. Put a slice in a bag in the dark, one in a bag in the sunlight and one in the refrigerator. Which one gets moldy first?	20
21	22 Let your child use scissors to cut paper and playdoh. This is a great fine motor activity.	23 Look at the clouds. Do you see any shapes? Have your child describe what they see.	24 Have your child circle or highlight all the capital letters in a newspaper or magazine.	25 Give your child a jump rope. How many jumps in a row can they complete?	26 Grow a <a href="#">bean in a clear cup</a> to watch the roots grow down and the stem grow up.	27
28	29 Go outside and blow bubbles. How many can your child catch?	30 Place an item in the box for each letter of the alphabet. Have your child take one item out and make its sound. Repeat.
