Lesson Objectives: By the end of instruction, students will:

1. Locate text based answers within informational text with 90% accuracy in 2 instances
2. Use a copy and paste function with 100% accuracy in 2 instances to identify the exact text used to answer a question

<p>Engage: Provide students with a framing question- “How did the early explorers use geography to find their destination”. Introduce content based vocabulary terms (3) to students.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Class Discussion
<p>Modeling:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Model opening document from teacher page ● Teacher reads Handout 1, article; review vocab and how to define unknown terms (navigation, guiding, instruments, latitude and longitude) ● Read question 1, locate answer, select it, paste it below the question ● Short discussion about how to copy/paste 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Read Text/Answer Questions
<p>Guided Practice and Exploration:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students open document from teacher page ● Together read first passage ● Student (or classroom) reads second question ● Ask student to come to board and selects and copy answer, while rest of Class does same ● Then paste copied text below question 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Read Text/Answer Questions
<p>Independent Practice and Elaboration:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Chorally read the second article ● Chorally read the third question ● Direct students to locate, select and paste the answer text ● If there is time, repeat for the fourth question ● Students must upload to teacher’s student upload page 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Read Text/Answer Questions
<p>Assessment/Evaluation: Teacher observation: exact text used to answer questions 3 and 4 must mirror teacher’s selection of text Save to H drive, upload to teacher page</p>
