

## **DR. WRIGHT SCHOOL MANDATORY UNIFORM POLICY**

The following will be required in September. All shirts are to be tucked into pants and belts are required. Belts must be plain, blue, brown or black only. Striped shirts, sweatpants, hooded sweatshirts, jeans, leggings and t-shirts (plain or with decals are not allowed). No sport or gym shorts. It is the responsibility of the parents to ensure that students come to school daily in uniform.

- Socks or tights: must be plain navy (no striped or designs)
- Different colored shirts under uniform are not allowed
- Bracelets are not allowed
- Large hoop earrings are not allowed. (two fingers cannot fit through it) or if the earring can be grabbed
- Sandals, flip flops, heels or high heel shoes are not allowed

### **Boys (Prekindergarten – Grade 8)**

Khaki colored pants (only)  
Navy blue polo shirt (only)  
Khaki shorts – knee length  
Navy blue sweater – no other colors are allowed  
School sweatshirt (or plain navy blue only)

### **Girls (Prekindergarten – Grade 8)**

Khaki colored pants (only)  
Khaki colored jumper or skirt (only) knee length  
Navy blue polo shirt (only)  
Navy socks or tights  
Khaki colored shorts – knee length  
Navy blue sweater – no other colors are allowed  
School sweatshirt (or plain navy blue only)

Parents choosing not to participate in the mandatory school uniform policy may apply for a transfer to another Buffalo Public School. Transfer applications are available through Central Registration School #12, 33 Ash Street.

Parents will be called and change of clothes must be brought to school for students who do not follow this policy.
