Required Materials:

The following materials are required and must be brought to class everyday.

1. A separate 2 inch binder for Spanish with a clear pocket in the front with 4 labeled dividers [Pregunta del dia, Apuntes, Tarea, Prueba/Exámenes]
2. Blue or black pens
3. Clean notebook paper or a spiral notebook that the paper can be easily torn out.
4. A Spanish-English Dictionary is recommended but not required. The above websites are available.
5. We will be using Realidades 3 textbook and workbook [The books will remain in the classroom and can be signed out if you feel you need additional practice] All of the resources are available online, both the textbook and student workbook. You will need access to a computer with Internet access on a regular basis to complete your assignments online.

**For extra credit you may choose to bring in tissues, pens, pencils or expo markers.

** Extra credit will be given throughout each quarter, I recommend taking advantage of these opportunities.

Grading Procedure:

Grades for this class are based on the following items that which will comprise your quarterly grades:

1. Being prepared to class- This means bringing all your materials to class and being prepared to work.
2. Homework [a minimum of 20 assignments per quarter]- Homework will not be accepted late!! Homework must be in the classroom on the day that it is due; I will not accept homework later in the day.
3. Quizzes and Tests- There will be a quiz or test EVERY Friday. There will be no excuse for not taking the quiz or test.
4. Projects and Writing Assignments- There will be 1 project per Unit and 1 writing assignment every 1-2 weeks.
5. Class Participation- Including your pregunta del dia and responding to class discussion questions.

Absences:

If a student is absent from school, it is his or her own responsibility to inquire about the work that was missed. School policy will apply to all work missed due to absence. You will have the same amount of days absent to make up the work. Extra help is always available before and after school. There is also tutoring provided through D'Youville at Leonardo Da Vinci High School.

Classroom Rules:

1. Arrive to class on time and prepared to work. Tardy to class without a pass will result in detention. Failure to be prepared to work will also result in a detention.
2. Follow directions and remain on task. Do not talk when I am talking.
3. Remain in your seat at all times, unless you have been given permission to move. I dismiss the class, not the bell. No lining up at the door prior to the bell.
