NEW YORK STATE TESTING



We are a few short months from the annual New York State Assessments in English Language Arts and Math. It is important that students be present the days they are supposed to take the test. - English Language Arts testing will be from Tuesday, April 5-Thursday, April 7.
- Mathematics testing will be given from Wednesday, April 13- Friday, April 15.
