CURRICULUM CORNER:

Reading: This month we will focus on comparing and contrasting and understanding characters in a story. Students will continue to orally blend phonemes and identify final sounds. They will build/read CVC and CVCV words with short and long vowels.

Writing: We will focus on writing informative sentences using details, sentence starters, capital letters, and punctuation (period, exclamation point, question mark). Students will continue to work on responding to a story using a complete sentence.

Math: We will begin Module 3. This module focuses on comparing length, weight, and capacity. Students will compare numbers of objects using language such as more than, less than, and same as. They will identify one more and one less. Students will fluently count to 100 and count by 10's and 5's to 100.
