



A collaborative learning environment ensures that all children reach their full potential.




The commitment from our Superintendent, the College Board, our Parents, Faculty, Staff and administration make our school one of a kind.

Sixth grade students study a unit on Pre-historic Art.






Providing students with equitable access to a quality education.

- A rigorous college preparatory program is the foundation of the courses offered.
- Students accepted in grades 6 and 9, upon entrance, are given diagnostic assessments to gage their academic readiness.
- A rich offering of extra-curricular activities and clubs provide students with the opportunity and structure to develop and build upon the social, organizational, academic and public speaking skills that are vital to their success in the 21st century.

- Each student is issued a Laptop computer. Wireless access to the internet is available to the students while in school.
- Curriculum, assessment and instruction are all aligned to the NYS Learning Standards with the emphasis on college entrance and success.
- Students begin the process of college exploration in grade 6.

Sixth grade students were instructed by Erie Community College professors for a day.


Students were lead by University at Buffalo students, highlighting what the university has to offer.
