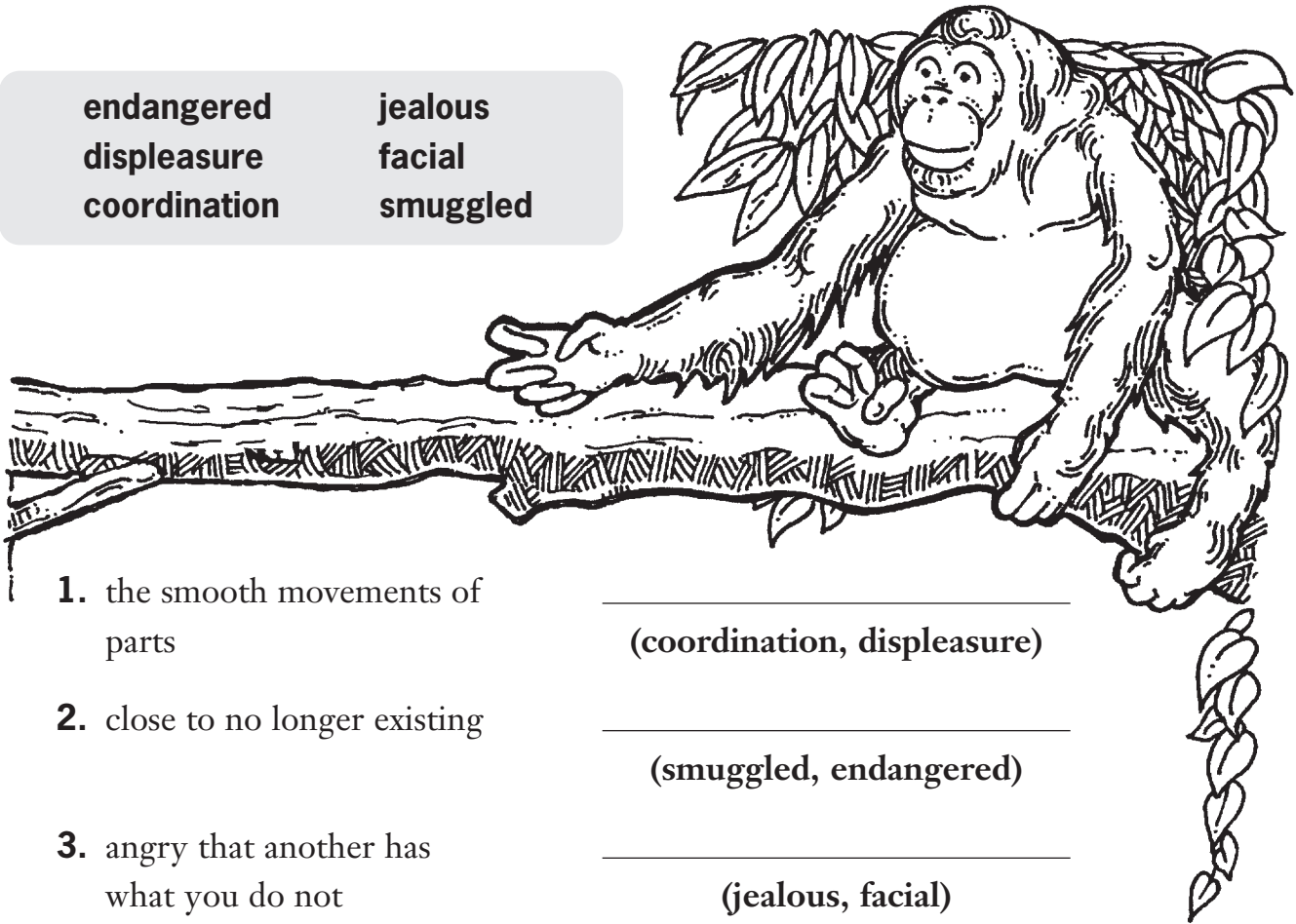

Prairie dogs live in underground towns. These towns are made up of rooms connected by tunnels. Some rooms are for sleeping, and others are for storing food. Some are nurseries, where young prairie dogs are raised. These towns include listening posts above ground. There, the prairie dogs listen for enemies.

When a prairie dog hears an enemy, it barks. This barking noise gave the prairie dog its name. The animal isn't really a dog. It is a type of ground squirrel. Sometimes prairie dogs stand on their hind legs, throw their heads back, and whistle. They may be letting other prairie dogs know that this is their territory.
